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

(c) Persons shall not be permitted to stand or sit in any of the intersecting gangways, or stand in any unseated place in the auditorium unless standing in such place has been specially allowed by the Watch Committee. (d) The safety curtain must be lowered at an early period during each performance so as to ensure its being in proper working order.

Scene 1

While a ball is in progress Young Treginnis is persuaded by three of his father's guests to show them the haunted ballroom. They are enchanted and express their desire to dance. The boy begs them not to do this and tries to explain the terrors of the room. Suddenly the Master of Treginnis enters. He is furious. He tells his guests how all his ancestors met their death in this ballroom. He asks them to leave, and he realises he is doomed to the fate of his ancestors.

Scene 2

The same, later. A Stranger Player summons the ghostly dancers, and three of these resemble the guests. The Master of Trginnis enters. He sees the Stranger Player, who tells him that his companions are dancers and that they will dance if he will lead them. He dances. They all join in. The dance becomes wilder and terror seizes him as he realises they will not let him stop, and that he cannot escape. He dances himself to death.

A ghostly bell awakens the house to the tragedy. They carry him away and Young Treginnis is left with the growing realisation that the fate of his father awaits him.

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
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


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
