Scene 1 The same. (Midnight).

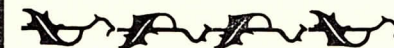
Scene 2 The same. (The following morning ; before breakfast).

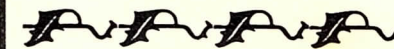
