MEARS

John Mears, Furniture Broker is recorded at the address in the 1879 Postal Directory

WARDEN

The 1881 Directory records Joseph Warden, Hairdresser and Umbrella Maker at 21 High Street. Joseph Warden, Hairdresser is found in the 1881 Census with his wife and 2 children.

SHORT

J Short, Saddler is recorded at 21 High Street according to the 1888-1899 Ward's Directory. He appears again in the 1902-1903 and the 1904-1905 , 1906-1907 1908-1909 1910-1911, 1912-1913 1914-1915 1917-1918 Ward's Directory.

The 1911 Census records John Short aged 64 years at the address with his wife Isabel and their 4 children. He is recorded as an employer. The premises is recorded as having 5 rooms.



CARR

The 1921-1922 Ward's Directory records F Carr Tobacconist & Smiley Printers

The 1924-1925, 1926-1927 and 1928-1929 Directory shows F Carr Tobacconist and A. V Dixon, Printers

By the 1930-1931 F Carr Tobacconist is the sole occupant recorded. This occupancy continues until the 1936-1937 Ward's Directory.
